## What type of material can be disposed of in a Construction Debris (C&D) dumpster?

### What type of material cannot be put into C&D loads?

Items specifically prohibited from arriving in C&D loads include, but are not necessarily limited to:

- White Goods
- Street sweeping debris
- Household garbage
- Glass or bottles
- Tires of any kind
- Waste oils
- Drums
- Septic tanks, grease traps
- Liquid and/or sludge
- Gas cans
- Batteries
- Fluorescent lights and ballasts
- Regulated asbestos containing materials (friable)
- Biomedical wastes
- PCBs
- Plastic buckets, unless completely empty

### What type of material cannot be put into your landfills?

Items specifically prohibited from entering landfills include:

- Hazardous wastes
- Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs)
- Biohazardous/biomedical wastes
- Used Oil
- Lead acid batteries (automobile batteries)
- Yard trash (prohibited in lined landfills)
- White goods (refrigerators, freezers, other appliance)
- Whole vehicle tires
- Free liquids
